Summary:	On 14 October 2022, Macys, Inc., the Registry Operator for .macys, notified ICANN that it wished to terminate the RA citing its own business needs. On 30 November 2022, ICANN made a preliminary determination that operation of the .macys gTLD need not be transitioned to a successor Registry Operator. On 16 February 2023, after a 30-day period for comments by interested parties, ICANN made a Final Determination to terminate the .macys Registry Agreement and revoke the TLD's delegation from the Root Zone.
