B.2 The DKE Office in Frankfurt am Main

By plane

At the **airport** please go to the station Regionalbahnhof. Take train S8/S9 direction Offenbach/Hanau (usually platform 1) for three stops and get off at the central station Hauptbahnhof.

At the **central station** Hauptbahnhof walk outside to the station square. Take tram No 16 (direction Offenbach/Stadtgrenze) or No 21 (direction Schwanheim) and get off at the second stop Stresemannallee/Gartenstraße.

On the left hand side of the stop (Apotheke/pharmacy) you will see the VDE/DKE-Offices Stresemannallee 15. From the central station Hauptbahnhof to Stresemannallee 15 you need about 12 min by foot.

A **taxi** needs about 20 min from the airport to Stresemannallee (approx. Euro 20,00).

From the central station Hauptbahnhof to Stresemannallee a taxi needs about 5 min (approx. Euro 7,50).

By public transport

At the **central station** Hauptbahnhof walk outside to the station square. Take tram No 16 (direction Offenbach/Stadtgrenze) or No 21 (direction Schwanheim) and get off at the second stop Stresemannallee/Gartenstraße.

On the left hand side of the stop (Apotheke/pharmacy) you will see the VDE/DKE-Offices Stresemannallee 15. From the central station Hauptbahnhof to Stresemannallee 15 you need about 12 min by foot.

A **taxi** needs about 20 min from the airport to Stresemannallee (approx. Euro 20,00).

From the central station Hauptbahnhof to Stresemannallee a taxi needs about 5 min (approx. Euro 7,50).

By car

Coming from the **North** (Kassel, Hannover - A5) or South (Darmstadt, Heidelberg - A5) you drive until you reach Frankfurter Kreuz. There you have to change to motorway A3 direction Würzburg and take motorway exit Frankfurt Süd (No 51).

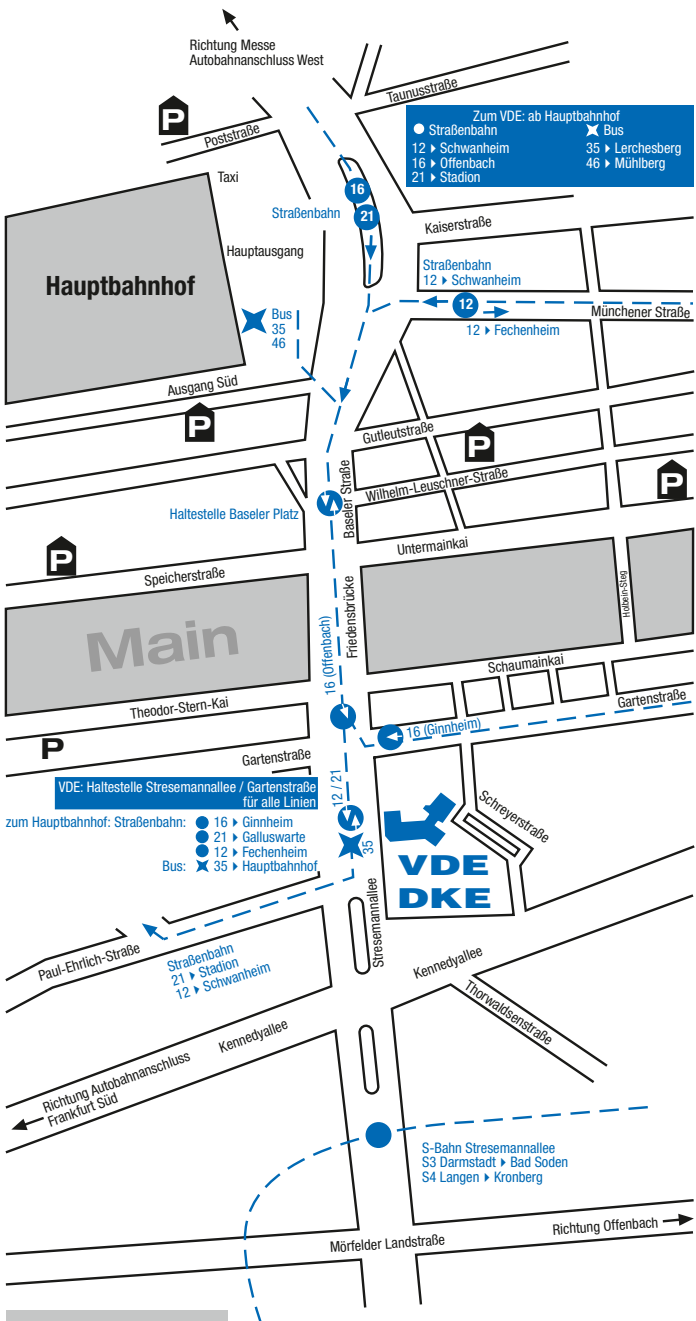
Coming from the **West** (Köln - A3) you drive to Frankfurter Kreuz where you have to change then to motorway A3 for taking motorway exit Frankfurt/Süd (No 51).

Coming from the **East** (Würzburg - A3) you only have to drive to motorway exit Frankfurt/Süd (No 51).

At **motorway exit Frankfurt/Süd** (No 51) you leave motorway A3 direction Stadtmitte/Stadion (B 43). You drive downtown - left hand side you will see the stadion - until you reach a roundabout with traffic lights. Now you take direction Stadtmitte. You have to leave the roundabout after about 200 m direction Stadtmitte (B 44). Follow the road - it is named Kennedyallee - about 2 km. After the fifth traffic light you reach a large crossroad (crossroads Kennedyallee/Stresemannallee). Driving left hand side direction Hauptbahnhof/Messe you will reach Stresemannallee. The VDE/DKE-Offices Stresemannallee 15 will be on your right after about 150 m.

Note: We recommend to use public transportation because there are only a few parking places available.
