  - used in Syriac as a disambiguation dot
  - used in Typicon Cyrillic, where the dot may have a square appearance
  - → 0358 combining dot above right
  - → 0740 : syriac feminine dot
- 1DF9 COMBINING WIDE INVERTED BRIDGE BELOW
  - used as a Typicon mark
  - → 033A g combining inverted bridge below
- 1DFA o **COMBINING DOT BELOW LEFT** 
  - used in Syriac as a disambiguation dot
- 1DFB Ő **COMBINING DELETION MARK** 
  - used for "mhusaa" in Newa scribal tradition

## Miscellaneous mark
