- ◆ *How to conduct the next Address Council election for the AP region?*



# AC Election Process

APNIC

## ◆ ASO MoU

### *Section 2(a) Selection.*

*(v) Selection of the RIR's members of the Address Council will be made via an open and transparent procedure. The individuals selected for the Address Council must not be staff members of any RIR.*

### *Section 2(b) Term.*

*The term of Address Council members will be 3 years. The initial Address Council members selected within each region will have staggered terms of 1, 2 and 3 years. The process by which these initial members are selected must also determine in an open and transparent manner, the assignment of terms to each of the initial members.*



# AC Election Process

APNIC

## ◆ ASO MoU

### ◆ Section 2(a) Selection.

- ◆ AC selection by open and transparent procedure
- ◆ Individuals selected must not be staff members of any RIR

### ◆ Section 2(b) Term.

- ◆ Term of Address Council members will be 3 years
- ◆ Initial members will have staggered terms of 1, 2 and 3 years
- ◆ Terms determined by open and transparent manner



# First AC Election

APNIC

- ◆ APNIC EC “Bootstrap” process due to lack of time and opportunity for meeting
  - ◆ Selection based on open nominations and expressions of support from AP community
- ◆ 3 AP members appointed in Oct 1999
  - ◆ Takashi Arano                      3 years
  - ◆ Hyunje Park                         2 years
  - ◆ Jianping Wu                         1 year\*

(\* ) member to be replaced in 2000 - 3 year term



# AP Election Options

APNIC

- ◆ Future elections in accordance with MoU section 2(a)
  - ◆ Election mechanism and electorate not specified
  - ◆ General (global) expectation of “openness”
  - ◆ Regional variations allowed...
- ◆ ARIN and RIPE NCC
  - ◆ Open meetings, anyone can vote
- ◆ APNIC
  - ◆ To be determined



# AP Election Options

APNIC

- ◆ What election mechanism?
- ◆ What electorate?
  - ◆ Open meeting like ARIN and RIPE NCC?
  - ◆ APNIC Members only?
    - ◆ Is this open enough?
  - ◆ Extended “Associate” membership?
    - ◆ Associates can only vote for AC members
    - ◆ Registration mechanism to ensure fairness etc



# AP Election Options

APNIC

## ◆ When?

- ◆ Second APNIC Member Meeting for 2000
- ◆ Need to select time and place

## ◆ Note: INET2000 Yokohama

- ◆ ICANN meetings will be held here
- ◆ Preferable to have AP-focussed venue/event (later in the year)
