 - 1 Member from the ARIN region attends each RIR meeting

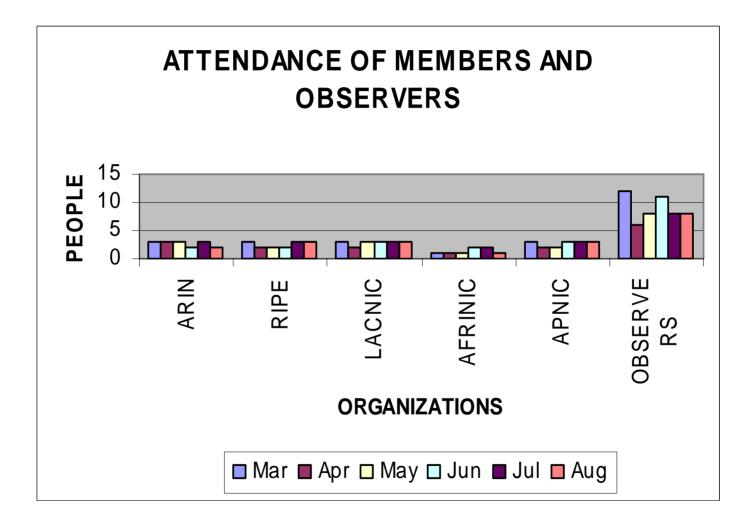

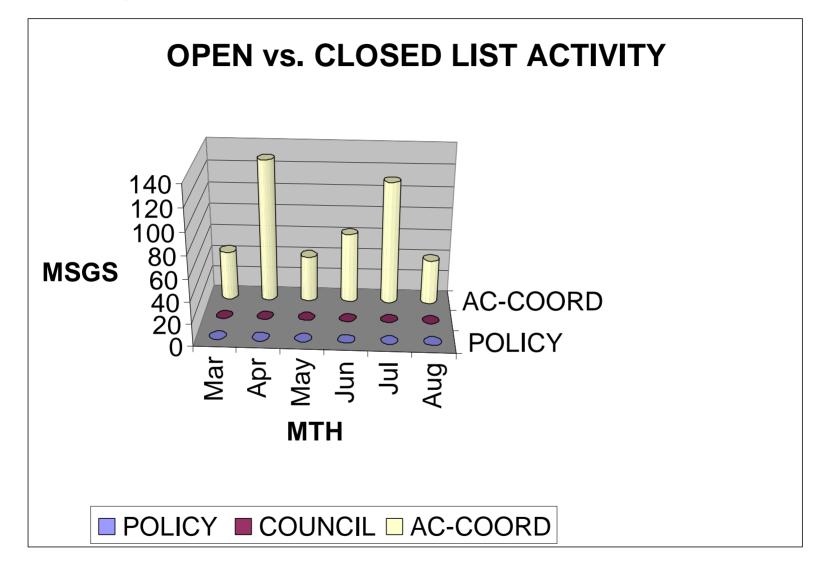

Since our last presentation.. (1)

- Sandy George was unanimously re-appointed to the ICANN NomCom for another 1 year term
- RIR to IANA Global Policy was ratified by the ASO AC and forwarded to the ICANN Board
- IANA to RIR Global Policy was ratified by the ICANN Board
- Global policy processing policy was created
- Chair nomination policy was created

Since our last presentation.. (2)

- IPV6 Global Policy was certified "compliant" to the ICANN Board
 - 13 Members agreed
 - 1 not present [1]
 - 1 abstained [2]
 - Undisclosed business conflict
 - RIR's were deemed to have followed their policy development procedures as required.
 - 1. Sylvia Geha Kezengwa, AfriNIC
 - 2. Martin Hannigan, ARIN

Feedback (1)

- Issues considered surrounding IANA to RIR Allocation Policy
 - Discussed on the AC-COORD list (July spike)
 - Ratification by 5 RIR's with /12 allocation unit size
 - ICANN Board feedback via IANA
 - Feedback sought from outside by ASO AC and IANA
 - Block size reduction only defers fragmentation issue
 - If /12 is an error, it can be fixed
 - IANA Manager Feedback to Board
 - The Final Result
 - ASO provided advice (Louie Lee for majority)
 - IANA Manager provided feedback (David Conrad for IANA)
 - Board reviewed
 - Ratified
