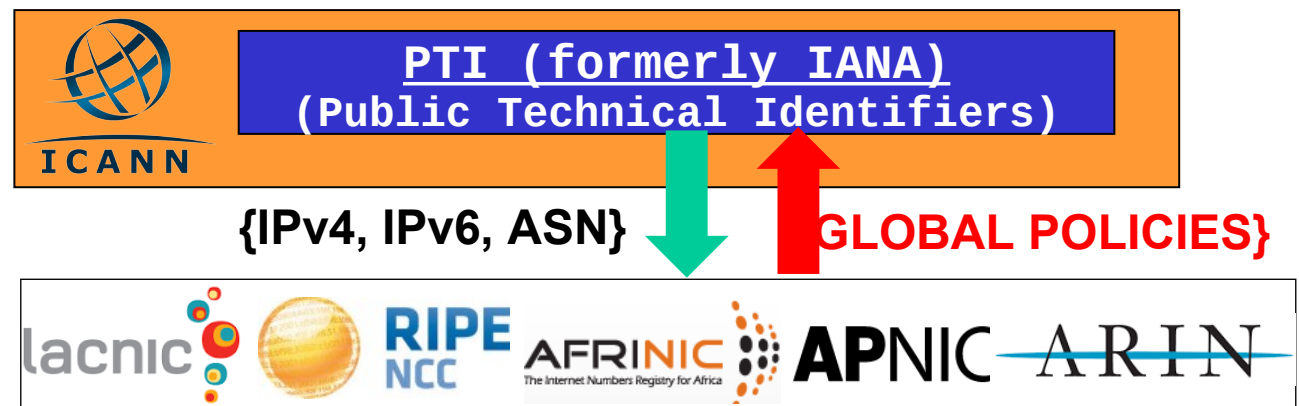

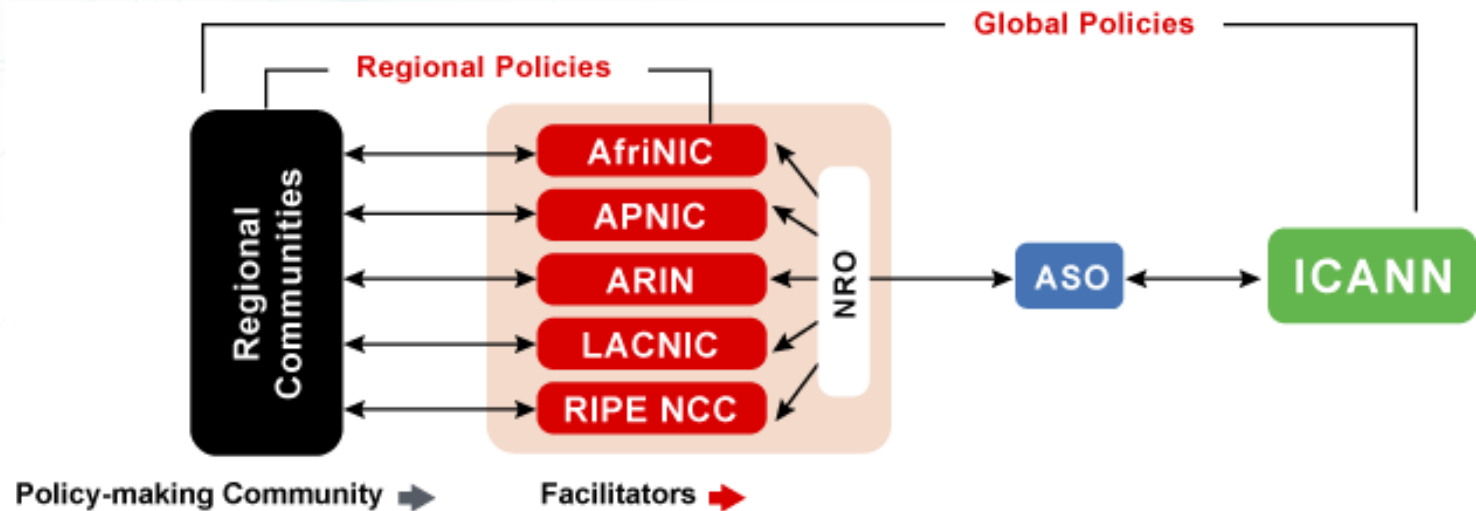
ICANN ASO/AC (Address Council)

Who is it?	The NRO Number Council
What is it?	Number Resource Policy Advisory Group
How is it organized ?	15 Members (3 from each region): <ul style="list-style-type: none">● 2 Elected community member● 1 appointed by RIR board RIR & ICANN observers
Term of office?	Diferent for every RIR (mostly 3 years)
What does it do?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Advise ICANN Board● Select ICANN Board Member (seat 9 and 10)● Select ICANN NOMCOM member (1)● Support Internet Number Global Policy Development
When does it meet?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Monthly by teleconference● Annually presential

ASO/AC Activities:

- A Global Policy
 - “Global policies are defined within the scope of this agreement as Internet number resource policies that have the agreement of all RIRs [Regional Internet Registries] according to their policy development processes and ICANN, and require specific actions or outcomes on the part of IANA or any other external ICANN-related body in order to be implemented.”
 - Global policies determine number allocation policy for requests that involve IANA
 - Global policies may also specify regional number allocation policy





- Each region has its own policy development process
 - All open, transparent, and bottom-up
- Global policy proposals are submitted in all 5 regions
- Each region follows its own process
- It then gets passed to the NRO for review
- And forwarded to the ICANN board

- Policy Proposal Facilitators Team (PPFT) 2018 was appointed in 1st meeting of 2018.
 - 1 member from each region
 - From LACNIC, **Jorge Villa** in the team.
- There are currently no Global Policy Proposals

We've been observing each RIR's policy forum if new global policy is proposed
