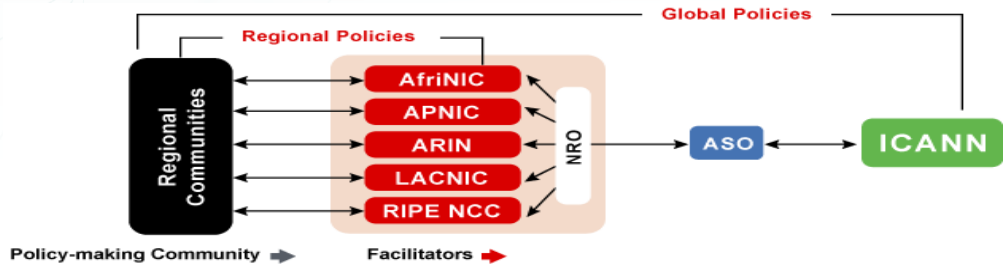

## ASO/AC Activities: Global Policy Management

- A Global Policy
  - “Global policies are defined within the scope of this agreement as Internet number resource policies that have the agreement of all RIRs [Regional Internet Registries] according to their policy development processes and ICANN, and require specific actions or outcomes on the part of IANA or any other external ICANN-related body in order to be implemented.”
  - Global policies determine number allocation policy for requests that involve IANA Services from PTI
  - Global policies may also specify regional number allocation policy

## Global Policy Development



- Each region has its own policy development process
  - All open, transparent, and bottom-up
- Global policy proposals are submitted in all 5 regions
- Each region follows its own process
- It then gets passed to the NRO for review
- And forwarded to the ICANN board






## ASO/AC Activities: Global Policy Management

- Policy Proposal Facilitators Team (PPFT) 2019 was appointed
  - 1 member from each region
  - From LACNIC, ***Esteba Lescano*** in the team.
- There are currently no Global Policy Proposals

We've been observing each RIR's policy forum if new global policy is proposed

- The selected candidate will serve for a three-year term, which will begin at the conclusion of the ICANN Annual General Assembly during the ICANN 66 Meeting, scheduled from 2-7 November 2019 in Montréal, Canada.
- Seat 10 is currently served by Asia Pacific representative Maemura Akinori.

## ICANN Board Seat 10 Election

### . Important Dates

- . **Nomination Phase:** 15 September 2018 – 30 November 2018
- . **Comment Phase:** 1 December 2018 – 15 January 2019
- . **ICANN Due Diligence for nominated candidates:** 1 – 15 January 2019
- . **Interview Phase:** 1 – 28 February 2019
- . **Selection Phase (deliberation):** 1 February 2019 – 14 March 2019
- . **Selection Phase (voting):** 15 – 21 March 2019
- . **Announcement of selected candidate:** around 22 March 2019
