- Correspondence New findability improvements include keyword(s) search allowing you to narrow your search within Correspondence files, an advanced year selector, a helpful subnavigation menu, and an improved table layout to enhance accessibility and readability.
- Board Meeting Materials We've made upgrades to this content type since the May 2020
 release. The keyword(s) search has been implemented and improved, and most Board Meeting
 files and pages from 1998-2019 are now available via filtered or keyword search.
- Acronyms and Terms Enhancements to the existing release include alignment with ITI's new
 user experience, additional terms added in all six U.N. languages, and a new sub-navigation
 menu.
