Composition of the ccNSO




ccNSO Members: ccTLD managers that have agreed in writing to be so.

 - Developing positions based on community input

- ccPDP3 Retirement of ccTLDs [Awaits implementation]
- ccPDP3 Review Mechanism [Board Report submitted] for decisions pertaining to:
 - delegation,
 - transfer,
 - revocation and
 - retirement of ccTLDs
- ccPDP4 IDN [Initial Report out for Public Comments]
 - to define the criteria, process, and procedures for (de)selecting Internationalized Domain Name country code Top Level Domain strings (IDN ccTLDS)
 - The results of this ccPDP4 will eventually replace ICANN's IDN ccTLD Fast Track Process.





- Individuals elected in their personal capacity and serve the ccTLD community.
- Councillors do not represent the views and interests of their employers.



Who can be a Councillor?

Anyone who has been:

- 1) **nominated** by a ccNSO member
- 2) seconded by a ccNSO member (same region)
- 3) **accepted** the nomination
- 4) **elected** by ccNSO members (from that region, if needed)




