The IGLC has been established to coordinate, facilitate, and increase the participation of ccTLD managers in discussions and processes pertaining to Internet Governance.

Membership of the Committee is open to all ccTLD managers (whether members of the ccNSO or not)

The committee counts approx. 15 members



The work we do

- Provide input to the ccNSO and share information on issues pertaining to Internet Governance discussions, events and processes.
- Ensure that such input as mentioned above is reflected in the ccNSO activities in discussions and processes pertaining to Internet Governance.
- The Committee may relate to and liaise with ICANN and/or other supporting organisations and advisory committees.

Examples

- IGLC 2021 **Action Plan**, to focus the IGLC's efforts
- Pointing ccTLDs to relevant sessions at ICANN public meetings
- Contributions to the **monthly ccNSO newsletter** with IG-relevant content
- A pre-ICANN72 ccTLD News **Session** on hot internet governance topics, from a regional perspective. The session was held on 7 October 2021. Consult the recordings [here](#).
- Internet Governance: What are the **hot topics**?

For instance, but not only:

1. Local content
2. Internationalised Domain Names (IDNs)
3. Regulations
4. Technical
5. Digital divide
6. Cybersecurity
7. Role of the ccTLDs as promoters of the IGF dialogues
8. Capacity building

- Each year the members of the Committee will be asked whether they want to continue to serve thereon.

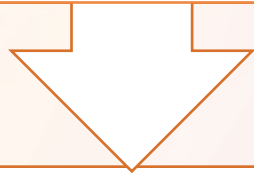
