### IGO-INGO Curative Rights PDP – Procedural Options for the GNSO Council

#### 1. Engage in (facilitated?) discussion with the GAC

- Not mutually exclusive with option to consult the Working Group
- Does not preclude the Council proceeding thereafter to vote in the way it thinks best

#### 2. Reject all five PDP recommendations

- Terminates the PDP (i.e. no policy recommendations will be sent to the Board)
- Status quo (i.e. current state of UDRP & URS) remains

#### 3. Accept all five PDP recommendations

 Board will receive recommendations in conflict with GAC advice (similar to what happened in the previous IGO-INGO PDP, including Red Cross issue)

#### 4. Accept Recommendations #1 - #4 and reject Recommendation #5

 Board will receive four recommendations that do not create/change Consensus Policy and do not reflect GAC advice

### 5. Send back Recommendation #5 (or all five recs.) to WG

- Consistent with PDP Manual but WG dynamics could be problematic
- Likely to create delay (interim reservation of IGO acronyms remain until PDP completed)

# 6. Consult WG on its deliberations on and rationale for Recommendation #5 (including Charter scope/interplay with RPMs)

- Consistent with PDP Manual but WG dynamics could be problematic
- May create delay (interim reservation of IGO acronyms remain until PDP completed)



## **Additional Background & Relevant Links**

- Scope of PDP: Working Group chartered to provide GNSO Council with recommendations
  regarding "whether to amend the UDRP and URS to allow access to and use of these
  mechanisms by IGOs and INGOs and, if so in what respects; or whether a separate,
  narrowly-tailored dispute resolution procedure at the second level modeled on the
  UDRP and URS that takes into account the particular needs and specific circumstances
  of IGOs and INGOs should be developed".
- Relevance to prior GNSO PDP on IGO-INGO Protections: Board wishes to act on all
  outstanding matters concerning overall protections for IGOs at the same time (i.e. curative
  rights and remaining recommendations from previous GNSO PDP); interim reservations for
  IGO acronyms remain in place until that occurs.
