

## *A SUCCESSOR TO W. G. FARGO.*

The Directors of the American Express Company held a meeting yesterday, and elected James C. Fargo as President, to fill the vacancy caused by the death of President William G. Fargo. Charles Fargo, of Chicago, was elected Second Vice-President. Ex-Senator Theodore M. Pomeroy, of Auburn, N. Y., will remain Vice-President of the company. James C. Fargo was also elected a Director of the Wells, Fargo & Co. Express, in place of William G. Fargo, and Senator Pomeroy was made a Director of the Merchants' Dispatch Transportation Company, to succeed the late Mr. Fargo.
