RE: New gTLD Application for .AMAZON

Dear Ambassador Diego Rivadeneira Espinosa,

I would like to thank you for your letter dated 5 April 2019.

Thank you for your recent communications regarding the Amazon corporation's applications for .AMAZON and related internationalized domain names. Your letter of <u>5 April 2019</u> has been posted to the <u>ICANN Correspondence page</u>.

The ICANN Board passed a resolution on 10 March 2019 offering time for the ACTO member states and Amazon corporation to reach a mutually agreeable solution. According to this resolution (as mentioned in your letter), the two parties were given a four-week period to reach a mutually agreeable solution. In addition, ICANN Board offered a potential two-week extension to the initial four-week period if both of the parties mutually agreed on the need to extend the initial time period.

The four-week period expired on 7 April 2019. ICANN did not receive mutual request for an extension from both parties; therefore, it was not possible to satisfy your extension request.
