On 12 March 2014, Public Interest Registry (PIR) submitted a Registry Services Evaluation Policy (RSEP) request to offer support for mandatory technical bundling of second level domain names for .NGO and .ONG. Upon review of the request, ICANN made a preliminary determination that the proposed Registry Service might raise significant Stability or Security issues (as defined in Sections 1.3 and 1.4 of the RSEP), and referred the proposal to the Registry Services Technical Evaluation Panel (RSTEP) (as defined in Section 1.5 of the RSEP), and simultaneously the RSEP request was posted for community input, in which no comments were received. The RSTEP prepared a written report regarding the proposed Registry Service's effect on Security or Stability.
