<p>On 12 March 2014, Public Interest Registry (PIR) submitted a Registry Services Evaluation Policy (RSEP) request to offer support for mandatory technical bundling of second level domain names for .NGO and .ONG. Upon review of the request, ICANN made a preliminary determination that the proposed Registry Service might raise significant Stability or Security issues (as defined in Sections 1.3 and 1.4 of the RSEP), and referred the proposal to the Registry Services Technical Evaluation Panel (RSTEP) (as defined in Section 1.5 of the RSEP).</p> <p>On 10 June 2014, the RSEP proposal was posted for public comment to seek community input on the request, in which no comments were received.</p> <p>Under the terms of the RSEP, the RSTEP shall prepare a written report regarding the proposed Registry Service’s effect on Security or Stability, which report shall be posted for public comment and subsequently forwarded to the ICANN Board along with a summary of any public comments for a decision.</p>
