Subject: Liaison on EPON-specific YANG Model

Thank you for your liaison reponse of July 13, 2017 regarding YANG in IEEE 802.3.

In our 4Q2017 meeting of Dec 4, 2017 the BBF received a contribution from a member requesting further development of EPON YANG models within the BBF. Prior to accepting this contribution and duplicating effort, BBF would like to receive an update on the current status of IEEE 802.3 EPON YANG model development.

As a rule, BBF makes an effort to reuse YANG models from other organizations. Depending on BBF requirements, this reuse may occur as a direct use of previously defined models by referencing them, it might result in proposals for changes of draft models, or it may result in BBF specific augmentations of standardized models.

We look forward to receiving an update on YANG modeling for EPON and working with IEEE 802.3 in coordinated fashion.
