Maintenance Item discussion:

- #3, Review the size related items in the modules. For size related to “small lists” look at removing the size leaf. For “large”, document what the size is for so the developer can understand the constraints of the implementation. There is no need for a must state because it is unclear (in some cases – read only) when the must statement would be evaluated.
- #4 is a maintenance item. Check the port number usage in the .1Q modules and fix accordingly
- #5 is like #3 and #5a is not an issue
- #6 is an instance of #3
- #7 component name discussion. Philosophy question: Does everything in the YANG module have to be found in Clause 12? AI: Don and William will work on a concise example of the issue and will communicate with the YANG Doctors for advice.
