

Title: Liaison on draft sharing and inclusive terminology to the IEEE 1588 Working Group

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Dear Colleagues,

IEEE P802.1ASdn specifies a YANG module that imports and augments `ieee1588-ptp.yang` specified in IEEE P1588e to meet the requirements for the management of IEEE 802.1AS. Although we rely on the publicly available `ieee1588-ptp.yang`, we would appreciate if you could share the most recent version of the IEEE P1588e draft with us that we would store with password-protected access.

Furthermore, we would like to note that some YANG objects specified by IEEE P1588e are visible in the YANG modules and in the trees specified by IEEE P802.1ASdn. Therefore, if IEEE P1588e includes non-inclusive terminology in its YANG modules, then IEEE P802.1ASdn will also include non-inclusive terminology. The IEEE 802.1 Working Group would appreciate if IEEE P1588e solely used inclusive terminology, as described in IEEE 1588g. This would allow the use of inclusive terminology in any YANG modules that augment the IEEE P1588e YANG modules. Thus, IEEE SA projects like IEEE P802.1ASdn could comply with the IEEE SA Standards Style Manual (in particular, section 10.5 Inclusive language).

We would appreciate your consideration in this matter and look forward to continued collaboration.
