 - Good response rate, 98% approval so far. One technical and one editorial comment on Figure 11-8.
 - e. 802.1AS-Rev/D1.0 available
 - TG ballot started
3. Tony performed comment resolution on 802.1Q-2014-Cor-1.
4. We reviewed the updated proposed comment responses to comments received from SC6 on
 - a. the 60-day pre-ballot of IEEE Std 802.
 - b. the FDIS ballots of 802.1AEbn and 802.1AEbw.

6. We reviewed the new maintenance items which have been received:
 - a. 0160: Spelling of “ageing” and “aging”
 - b. 0161: Minor errors and typos in 802.1AS FSMs for 802.11 links
 - c. 0162: Writeability of certain 802.1AE-2006 MIB variables
 - d. 0163: 802.1AX-2014: DRNI - one and only one aggregator
7. We reviewed the status of 802.1 drafts and standards progressed under the PSDO to ISO SC6 JTC1.
