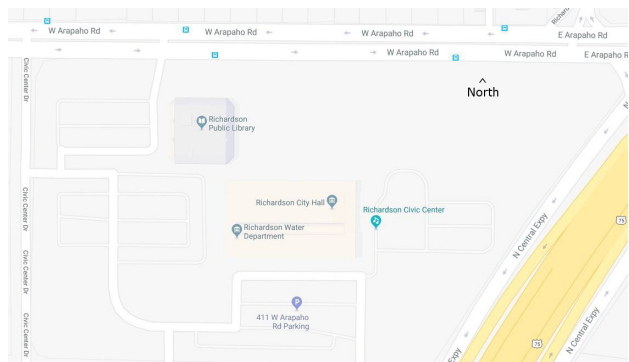

Driving Notes

The Richardson Civic Center is located on the southwest corner of the intersection of West Arapaho and US 75. The Civic Center is flanked by the Richardson Library, which is the one building in the complex that fronts on Arapaho Road.

The meeting rooms are across the hall from what Google calls the Richardson Water Department. Therefore, the best entrance is on the opposite end of the building from the one shown. Park on the south or west side of the building. Picture is west end viewed from the south.



The Civic Center opens at 8 am and the meetings are scheduled to start at 9 am.

The Richardson room is where the City Council holds its working meetings, which accounts for the modern facilities. The official Council chamber, where public meetings are held, is located around the corner.

In addition to all the other code violations that are possible, it is a violation for anyone who is not a city employee to move the furniture. Therefore, the host will be present early to ensure that everything is in its place.

[†] The Richardson Civic Center is also Richardson City Hall. Because of the large number of code inspectors present in the building, code enforcement is very strict (e.g., too many people in a room).
